**UNIDATA AMONG THE PROTAGONISTS OF THE TEMPORARY GROUPING OF COMPANIES AWARDED OF THE IMPORTANT AND INNOVATIVE #ROMA5G PROJECT TO TRANSFORM THE CAPITAL INTO A SMART CITY AMONG THE MOST ADVANCED IN EUROPE**

**UNIDATA WILL CREATE THE DIGITAL INFRASTRUCTURES ENABLING Wi-Fi, IoT AND 5G SERVICES**

**THE NEW 5G INFRASTRUCTURE WILL BE ABLE TO PROVIDE ADVANCED CONNECTIVITY IN ALL THE MOST FREQUENT PLACES OF THE CAPITAL CITY, INCREASING PUBLIC SAFETY AND ENABLING SMART SERVICES**

**Roma, 12 December 2023 – Unidata S.p.A. (UD.MI)**, operator of telecommunications, cloud and IoT services, listed on Euronext Milan – STAR Segment, organized and managed by Borsa Italiana S.p.A., announces that it is part of the Temporary Grouping of Companies – composed by Boldyn Networks (leader), Unidata S.p.A., IFM S.p.A. and Cecchini S.r.l. – winners of the concession contract with the Municipality of Rome for the construction, management, operation and maintenance of 5G and Wi-Fi infrastructures in the area of Roma. The #Roma5G project was awarded through a Public Private Partnership (PPP) and the related concession will have a duration of 25 years.

The entire project involves coverage of all metro lines, installation of over 2,200 signal propagation points for small cells, development of the public Wi-Fi network with 850 access points in 100 squares, installation of 1,800 IoT sensors and 2,000 5G cameras for an increasingly safe and smart capital city, also in view of the next Jubilee which will take place in 2025. The #Roma5G project is also conceived with respect for environmental sustainability, being based on the small-cell system which involves reduced energy consumption and low electromagnetic emissions.

The project will allow Roma to equip itself with an attractive technological infrastructure for businesses, new services for citizens and tourists and to become a true Smart City. With this modernization intervention, the aim is to have full connectivity in all the key points of the Capital City, to increase public safety thanks to video surveillance systems and to enable a large portfolio of digital services, including free Wi-Fi and environmental control sensors at high traffic points.

Thanks to the consolidated experience developed over the last 20 years in the metropolitan area of the Municipality of Rome and more recently in the grey areas of Lazio and Puglia regions, Unidata will have the opportunity to actively contribute to the project by making its know-how available for the creation of digital infrastructures for the Capital City.

It will be a great opportunity to further use and enhance the large fiber optic network that we have built in recent years”.*
